For the third year in a row The House of Seven Gables will allow Salem Arts members on the grounds of their property to sketch, paint, photograph, and write without the need to pay admission.

This year there will be guidelines (regarding use of their furniture and the need to sign in so that they know who is on the grounds). We will provide them with a list because for the first time SAA will require that you fill out this Call for Proposal to participate and pay a fee. They want emails and phone numbers of the artists in attendance. We will be able to "hang" our work for two days and we will have a reception on June 7<sup>th</sup>, the Sunday closing the Salem Arts Festival.

Art Dick Up: June  $8^{th}$  from 4-5 pm (not during the reception on 6/7, if you cannot leave your work through the  $8^{th}$  please do not enter the exhibition.) June  $9^{th}$  from 10 am to 2 pm.
